

NFL-N4A Advisory Committee Bylaws
ADOPTED - 9/10/07

- I. The NFL –N4A Advisory Committee will consist of nine members. They are the following: (1) the current N4A president, (2) an N4A representative from each of the five N4A regions, (3) an at-large N4A member, (4) the NFL continuing education program consultant, (5) the NFL continuing education program manager, and 6) an NFL Player Development Director.**
- II. Committee members shall serve on the advisory committee for a maximum of three consecutive years. Terms limits will be staggered to ensure continuity.**
- III. Committee members are expected to participate in conference calls arranged by the committee chair or the NFL continuing education program manager.**
- IV. Committee members are expected to attend their respective N4A regional conference and perform duties as determined by the committee chair (e.g., gathering data and/or reporting on committee goals and initiatives).**
- V. Committee members will be expected to attend the yearly meeting held at the N4A national conference.**
- VI. Committee members will serve as contacts for the NFL continuing education program as it pertains to getting players re-enrolled in school.**
- VII. Advisory committee members will be chosen by current members.**
- VIII. Advisory committee applicants are required to complete a formal written application form.**
- IX. Failure to comply with any of the above bylaws may lead to dismissal from the committee as determined by the NFL continuing education program manager and the committee chair.**
