

COMMITTEE GOALS:

Enhance Visibility of the Committee

 - c. Re-admission procedures and tuition, and fees.
 - d. Applicable policies for transferring courses not taken at degree granting institution (ex. last 30 credits must be taken in residence or at degree granting institution.).
 - e. Degree completion incentive programs offered by professional league.

Data Collection

1. Create a user-friendly process that allows members to submit data (Non-graduates pursuing pro sports career).
2. Compare N4A data with professional league data.
